


The UEFA Futsal B Licence Pathway

B Licence Design a licence that meets minimum criteria

UEFA Inform UEFA in writing that you are ready for evaluation

Paperwork Provide comprehensive paperwork about the course

Evaluation A UEFA futsal expert will visit your association and report to UEFA Jira Panel

Tutor Futsal expert can act as tutor but you must implement with own instructors

Jira Panel Expert reports to Jira Panel

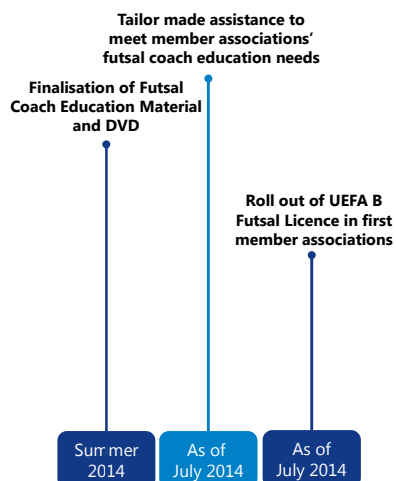
